Each Non-Profit group will get **one** Parking Pass which will allow access into the park to set-up and a parking spot while available at the Township Building. Parking is on a first come, first serve basis. We mail parking passes out about a week before the date of the event. In the case of a rainout we will try to contact the Saturday representative by 8:30am. **All registrations must be received by May 7, 2010.**

Horsham Day Non-Profit Rules

IT IS VERY IMPORTANT THAT YOUR ORGANIZATION ADHERE TO THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES AND RULES – HORSHAM TOWNSHIP RESERVES THE RIGHT TO ASK ANY ORGANIZATION WHO VIOLATES THE GUIDELINES BELOW TO LEAVE THE PREMISES ON HORSHAM DAY. WE APOLOGIZE IN ADVANCE FOR RESERVING THE RIGHT TO EXPULSION, WHICH MAY SEEM TO BE A DRASTIC MEASURE. DUE TO A FEW UNFORTUANTE EXPERIENCES WE HAD IN THE PAST, WE NEED TO RESERVE THIS RIGHT TO MAINTAIN ORDER, AS WELL AS A SAFE AND COMFORTABLE ENVIRONMENT FOR OUR HORSHAM RESIDENTS AND HORSHAM DAY PARTICIPANTS.

- You may not sell or donate water to the public.
- You are not permitted to bring any combustible device on the premises including but not limited to smoke bombs, fireworks, and blow torches.
- The following items may not be brought onto the premises as they create a clean-up nuisance and if used incorrectly may damage township property: spray paint, silly string.
- Any item which causes damage to person or property is not permitted.
- Religious organizations are limited to distributing literature at their locations.
- Organizations may not sell food, with the exception of bake sale goods. The items for sale at a bake sale may only consist of baked items cooked and be prepared off township premises.
- If any organization provides an item to Horsham Day participants which causes or promotes public unrest or disorderly conduct at Horsham Day, the Director of Horsham's Park and Recreation Department may confiscate the items or ask you to cease distributing such items.
