 - Registration goes until March

- Pavilions will be opened for rentals April 17th

Director's Report

- Handed out permits to sports organizations in attendance
 - Horsham Little League / Horsham Heat / All In Baseball
- Horsham Heat expressed concern about how much field time they were allotted
 - Kyle Lynch said he would speak with other organizations and see if they could give Heat one weeknight on Carpenter Baseball Field
- Kyle worked alongside Fisher & Son to get the 2022 fertilizer and seed plan scheduled for the year
 - Nick Bellizzie asked if Public Works ever spread the fertilizer Horsham Soccer purchased last year and Kyle said he would investigate it and get back to Nick
- Little League and Horsham Public Works decided to phase out field #11 in Deep Meadow as it was heavily damaged by the storm and in a flood plain
- Public Works and Little League will be addressing issues with the aging amenities in Deep Meadow Park
 - Replacing damaged chain link fence
 - Fixing the poor drainage throughout Deep Meadow
- Pickleball
 - 2022 yearly sign-ups are open – currently have 136 out of a possible 200 members
 - Indoor play in the community center is gaining popularity
