President Tustin, following the Conditional Use Hearing for 1300 Easton Road, opened the Council meeting with a Pledge of Allegiance at 7:18 PM in the Township Building, 1025 Horsham Road, Horsham, PA.

Ms. Tustin asked for questions or comments from the public. There were none.

PECO Energy Company was in attendance to recognize the Township Tricentennial. Council was presented a framed photo of the “Horsham Township Celebrates Tricentennial 1717-2017” that appeared in the crown lights atop the PECO Headquarters in Center City on September 9, 10 and 11. Suzanne Ryan, PECO External Affairs Manager, presented the framed photo.

Mr. Walker reviewed for Council the 2017/2018 PennDOT Snow and Ice Agreement. Ms. Tustin asked for the will of Council concerning the agreement. It was moved by Mr. McCouch, second by Mr. Whiteside to authorize the PennDOT Snow and Ice Agreement for the 2017/2018 season and further authorize execution of same. Motion passed unanimously.
